## 3. <u>REQUIRED ATTACHMENT(S)</u>:

- A. A member seeking removal of a non-practice exemption must attach certification of completion of sufficient CLE credits for each educational year during which he or she was exempt, excluding the current educational year. In no case shall a member be required to certify completion of more than 12 credits, including 2 ethics credits, as a condition of removal of the exemption. *Applicants may contact CLE Staff to determine the number of credits necessary for exemption removal.*
- B. Attachments to this application must consist of **completed** attendance certificates to total the requisite credits for removal of the exemption.Timely certification shall include only credits earned during the current educational year and two prior educational years. If the requisite credits have previously been reported and appear on your CLE record, resubmission is not necessary.
- 4. The Commission shall approve the application for removal of a non-practice exemption if it appears that the member has satisfied the requirements of this Rule. The member shall be notified in writing of the Commission's action on the application for the removal of the exemption.
- 5. <u>IMPORTANT NOTICE</u>: Removal of the applicant's non-practice exemption in no way affects the member's responsibility to complete the current year minimum educational requirement by June 30<sup>th</sup>. The current year minimum educational requirement must be completed as set forth at SCR 3.645.
