



Bluegrass Crime Stoppers Board opening announcement

Bluegrass Crime Stoppers is a nonprofit organization dedicated to enhancing public safety. Located in central Kentucky, we have the unique opportunity to serve a large area of our state.

Mission Statement: The mission of Bluegrass Crime Stoppers is to provide a confidential and anonymous communication channel between the community and law enforcement, supporting the "see something, say something" approach to improving community safety.

We are currently seeking applicants for a board position as our attorney, preferably a civil attorney with experience in contract law. The designated member will serve as the organization's legal advisor, assisting with contract and agreement review, as well as providing guidance on updates to bylaws and operating agreements. This position also includes participation on the executive committee.

- **Time Commitment:** The board convenes once a month in Lexington at Members Heritage Credit Union from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM, with lunch provided. Additionally, members are expected to dedicate at least one hour per month outside of meetings to support the organization's mission.
- **Term:** Board members serve three-year terms, with the possibility of renewal.

Being a member of the Bluegrass Crime Stoppers board offers an opportunity to make a meaningful and measurable difference in the community. Over the past five years, Bluegrass Crime Stoppers has contributed to solving more than 20 homicides and has facilitated the removal of significant quantities of drugs, weapons, and illegal items from our neighborhoods, with an average payout of approximately \$33,000 annually to tipsters by leveraging our confidential tip reporting system. In this way, community members can provide information regarding crimes or wanted persons, which is then relayed to the appropriate law enforcement agencies while remaining anonymous.
