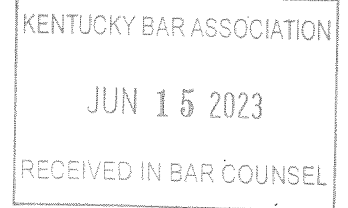

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the 181-day probated suspension is imposed upon William David Rye, as requested by the Kentucky Bar Association in its motion filed on January 26, 2023. Rye's 181-day suspension is imposed because of his failure to show cause and his failure to comply with the terms of his probation as provided for in this Court's Opinion and Order dated December 16, 2021.

Pursuant to SCR 3.390, Rye, if he has not already done so, shall, within ten days from the entry of this Order, notify all clients in writing of his inability to represent them, and notify all courts in which he has matters pending of his suspension from the practice of law, and furnish copies of said letters of Notice to the Office of Bar Counsel.

During the time of his suspension, Rye shall not accept new clients or collect unearned fees.

Pursuant to SCR 3.390, Rye shall, to the extent possible, immediately cancel and cease any advertising activities in which he is engaged.
